This blockbuster book covers 5,000 years of the Black medical experience. It is an essential resource for anyone involved or interested in the racist, dysfunctional system that is American medicine.

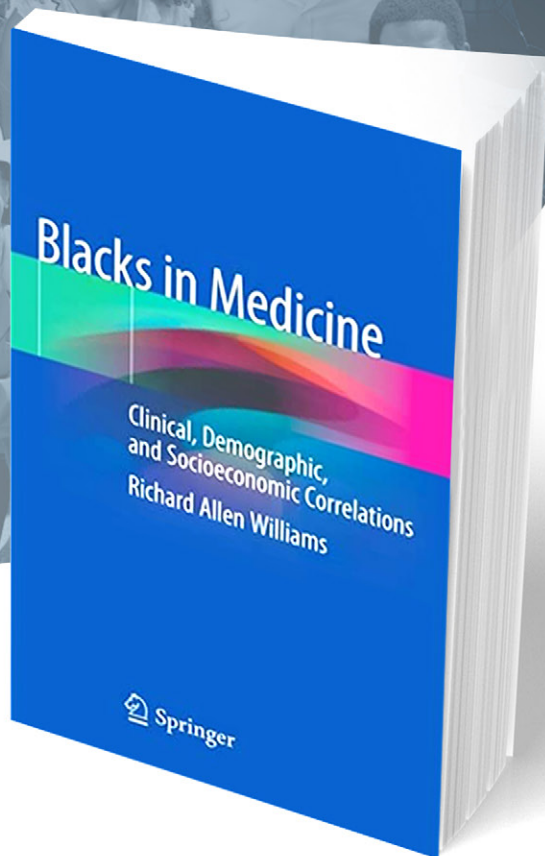
